**8<sup>th</sup> Advanced Course on Aerobiology**

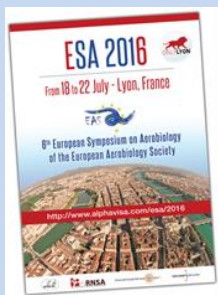
